

Grand Strand Photo Safari With Bill Jordan

Wed Noon-March 31st to Thur Noon-April 1st, 2010

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION: to capture the full breadth of photo shoot opportunities along the Grand Strand, a workshop with Bill Jordan starts before sunrise and finishes after sunset, so to call this a one-day workshop is far too conservative. Bill will include his favorite places along the Grand Strand to share his photographic skills and knowledge. This is all about putting us to work in the field, then getting his comments on the photos we have taken. Bill always travels with “his truck”, and he will share “what’s in the truck” so he never forgets anything. Some photos included from Grand Strand areas we might visit in this workshop.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

- You will learn tips & tricks on how to better use your camera, regardless of point & shoot to full blown DSLR;
- You will learn to use histograms which is Bill’s presentation Thursday, April 1st;
- You will take pictures using a tripod and handheld;
- You will take pictures in low light and full daytime to better understand exposure (aperture, shutter speed and ISO);
- You will gain ideas for better composition, rules for composition, and when to break rules;
- And much more!



WORKSHOP MAXIMUM: 12 is the maximum for this workshop; if we have enough interest, we will find out if Bill would do a second one-day workshop while he is here; and this would probably be Friday-April 2nd (which is Good Friday); BUT, we need 12 for the first workshop before scheduling a second workshop; this is strictly first registered will be first to save a slot!!

PHOTO SHOOT LOCATIONS: some possible locations will be Myrtle Beach for ocean, Murrells Inlet for sunrise, Pawleys Island for sunset, Georgetown for landscape and river scenes, and many options for marsh scenes and birds.



DATE/DAY/TIME:

- Wed Noon-Mar 31 thru Thur Noon-Apr 1
- Sunrise about 7AM and Sunset about 7PM
- This is a full day starting Wed-Noon, going thru sunset, starting again before sunrise and closing at Thur-Noon

PRICE/INVESTMENT: the best \$100 for the day you will ever invest in yourself. Dutch Treat for breakfast and lunch (dinner on your own after sunset). For non-members, \$125 which includes \$25 for membership (\$235 for a couple; \$200 for workshop, \$35 for couple membership).



WHAT TO BRING/WHAT TO WEAR: bring as much or as little of all your camera gear (remember you have to lug it around). Wear comfortable clothes, and bring a jacket in case it is a little chilly at sunrise or sunset (early April can be comfortable, cool, and sometimes a little warm).

OUR WORKSHOP LEADER: Bill Jordan has participated in our MBCC programs in 2009, and again in 2010; he has decades of photography experience and sharing this in photo safaris, workshops & presentations; Bill lives in Columbia and has made countless

trips to the Grand Strand and is extremely qualified to be our team leader; I like to say, Bill has forgotten more about photography than most people have learned.
